



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Grand Wood Park Retirement Residence – London

Middlesex-London Public Health declared the COVID-19 outbreak at Grand Wood Park Retirement Residence in London to be over as of today. The outbreak was declared on August 13 after two residents tested positive for COVID-19. The cases have now resolved.

Residents and families have been informed that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected by the outbreak.

We appreciate the support of Middlesex-London Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear appropriate personal protective equipment at all times.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our retirement residences and long term care homes.
