



Media Statement – COVID-19 Outbreak at Meadowlands Retirement Residence – Medicine Hat

Alberta Health Services (AHS) declared an outbreak at Meadowlands retirement residence on August 12 after one staff tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member is in self isolation at home.

We are working closely with AHS officials to implement pandemic outbreak protocols and infection control practices. All staff are screened at the beginning and end of their shifts and are required to wear a surgical mask and eye protection in the residence at all times.

We are doing enhanced cleaning at Meadowlands, disinfecting high touch surfaces like handrails and doors, resident rooms, common areas and staff rooms frequently.

Residents of Meadowlands who have consented, and are able to be vaccinated, have received their second dose. Staff vaccinations are also underway.

Revera continues to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our retirement residences and long term care homes.
