



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Oak Terrace Long Term Care Home – Orillia

We received notice today from Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit (SMDHU) that the COVID-19 outbreak at Oak Terrace Long Term Care Home in Orillia is over. The outbreak was declared on July 30 after two staff members tested positive for COVID-19. Both cases have since resolved.

We appreciate the support of SMDHU, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear appropriate personal protective equipment at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
