



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at ReachView Village Long Term Care Home – Uxbridge

On August 6, Durham Region Public Health declared the COVID-19 outbreak at ReachView Village Long Term Care Home in Uxbridge to be over.

We appreciate the support of Durham Region Public Health, the Township of Uxbridge, our families and the local community as we worked to contain the spread of COVID-19 in the home. The team at ReachView Village offers our most sincere condolences to the families and friends of the people we have lost to COVID-19.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear surgical masks and face shields or goggles at all times. Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in isolation and tested for COVID-19.

We have resumed resident visits and families of residents have been advised of the process for making arrangements to visit.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
