



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Constitution Place Retirement Residence – Mississauga

We received notice today from the Region of Peel Public Health, that the COVID-19 outbreak at Constitution Place Retirement Residence in Mississauga is over. The outbreak was declared on December 12 after one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. This has been resolved.

We appreciate the support of the Region of Peel Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the residence.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
