



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Green Falls Landing Retirement Residence - Regina

We received notice today from Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Green Falls Landing in Regina is over. The outbreak was declared on November 13 after two staff members tested positive for COVID-19. All cases have resolved.

We appreciate the support of Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We have reached out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
