



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Kildonan Personal Care Centre – Winnipeg

We received notice yesterday from Winnipeg Regional Health Authority that the COVID-19 outbreak at Kildonan Personal Care Centre in Winnipeg is over. The outbreak was declared on December 4 after one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. During this outbreak, a total of two staff members tested positive for COVID-19. Both cases have resolved.

We appreciate the support of the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are reaching out to residents and their families to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over that no residents were affected.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
