



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at King Gardens Retirement Residence – Mississauga

We received notice today from Peel Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at King Gardens Retirement Residence in Mississauga is over. The outbreak was declared on October 30 with 11 residents and 9 staff members, tested positive for COVID-19 during the outbreak. All cases have resolved.

We appreciate the support of Peel Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home. We regret to confirm that two residents passed away with COVID-19 during the outbreak. The team at King Gardens Retirement Residence offers its most sincere condolences to the families and friends of the residents who passed away.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
