



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Lakeview Care Centre Long Term Care Home –
Vancouver**

We received notice today from Vancouver Coastal Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Lakeview Care Centre Long Term Care Home in Vancouver is over. The outbreak was declared on November 26 after three staff members tested positive for COVID-19. All positive staff are recovering in isolation at home. There was no additional exposure to Lakeview Care Centre.

We appreciate the support of Vancouver Coastal Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
