



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Main Street Terrace Long Term Care Home – Toronto

On December 4, we received notice from Toronto Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Main Street Terrace Long Term Care Home in Toronto has been declared over. The outbreak began on October 15 after three residents and one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. We offer our most sincere condolences to the families and friends of the nine residents we lost to the pandemic.

We appreciate the support of Toronto Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home. Special thanks go to the team from Michael Garron Hospital who provided important guidance, support and staffing resources during outbreak.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
