



Media Statement – Outbreak over at Royal City Manor Long Term Care Home – New Westminster, B.C.

Fraser Health announced today that the COVID-19 outbreak at Royal City Manor Long Term Care Home in New Westminster is over. The outbreak was declared on December 1 after one resident and three staff members tested positive for COVID-19. In total, two residents and three staff members tested positive during the outbreak. All cases have resolved.

We appreciate the support of Fraser Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We have informed residents and their families that the outbreak has ended.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
