



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at The Churchill Retirement Residence – Edmonton

We received notice on December 27 from Alberta Health Services that the COVID-19 outbreak at The Churchill Retirement Residence in Edmonton is over. The outbreak was declared on November 24, 2020 after two staff members tested positive for COVID-19. Over the course of the outbreak, two more staff members and two residents tested positive. All cases have resolved.

We appreciate the support of Alberta Health Services, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the residence.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We have informed residents and their families that the outbreak has been declared over.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our retirement residences and long term care homes.
