



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at West Oak Village Long Term Care Home – Oakville

On December 14, we received notice from Halton Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at West Oak Village Long Term Care Home in Oakville was over. The outbreak was declared on November 24 after one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. Since the outbreak started, a total of three staff members tested positive for COVID-19. Those cases have since resolved.

We appreciate the support of Halton Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
