



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Beacon Hill Lodge Personal Care Home – Winnipeg

We received notice today from Winnipeg Regional Health Authority that the COVID-19 outbreak at Beacon Hill Lodge Personal Care Home in Winnipeg is over. The outbreak was declared on September 1 after one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. During this outbreak, 18 residents and 16 staff members tested positive for COVID-19.

We regret to confirm that one resident passed away with COVID-19 during the outbreak; this person had been on end-of-life care. The team at Beacon Hill Lodge offers its most sincere condolences to this person's family and friends and to all who have been affected by this terrible virus.

We appreciate the support of Winnipeg Regional Health Authority, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
