



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Elginwood Long Term Care Home – Richmond Hill

We received notice on February 4 from Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Elginwood Long Term Care Home in Richmond Hill is over. The outbreak was declared on January 18 after three staff members tested positive for COVID-19. All cases have resolved.

We appreciate the support of York Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We have reached out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

All residents, who provided consent and were able to be vaccinated, have received both doses. Vaccinations for staff are underway.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
