Toronto Public Health declared the outbreak of COVID-19 at the Harold and Grace Baker Centre in Toronto to be over on February 13.

The team at Harold and Grace Baker Centre offers its most sincere condolences to the family and friends of the resident who passed away during this outbreak, which began in the Long Term Care area on January 16.

We appreciate the support of Toronto Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
