



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Kennedy Lodge Long Term Care Home – Scarborough

We received notice today from Toronto Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Kennedy Lodge Long Term Care Home in Scarborough is over. The outbreak was declared on January 7 after one resident and two staff members tested positive for COVID-19. During this outbreak, 15 residents and 9 staff members tested positive for COVID-19.

We regret to confirm that two residents passed away with COVID-19 during the outbreak. The team at Kennedy Lodge offers its most sincere condolences to the families and friends of the people we have lost to the pandemic.

We appreciate the support of Toronto Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home. Our hearts go out to all who have been affected by this terrible virus.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over.

All Kennedy Lodge residents who consented to and are able to be vaccinated have now received their second dose. Vaccinations for staff are on-going.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
