



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at McKenzie Towne Continuing Care Centre – Calgary

We received notice today from Alberta Health Services Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at McKenzie Towne Continuing Care Centre in Calgary is over. The outbreak was declared on February 1 after one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. This case has been resolved. The outbreak did not involve any residents or staff members of McKenzie Towne Retirement Residence.

We appreciate the support of Alberta Health Services, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

McKenzie Towne residents, who consented to or were able to be vaccinated, have now received their second dose. Staff vaccinations are on-going.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
