



**Media Statement – Harold & Grace Baker Centre Long Term Care Home - Dr. Rhonda Collins,
Chief Medical Officer, Revera**

April 12, 2020

We can confirm that eleven residents and nine staff at Harold & Grace Baker Centre Long Term Care Home in York, Ontario, have tested positive for COVID-19. The residents are in isolation and the staff members are in self-isolation at home. All confirmed positive residents are from the long term care home. No residents from the retirement side have been tested positive for COVID-19.

It is with our deepest regrets that we confirm that two residents have passed away with COVID-19. We extend our most sincere and heartfelt condolences to the family and friends of these residents.

We are working closely with public health officials and are following strict infection control practices. All staff providing care for residents in isolation (positive or symptomatic) must wear full personal protective equipment (PPE) which includes a mask, face shield, gloves and gown, while providing care. All staff have been directed to wear a surgical mask at all times.

We continue to do enhanced cleaning at Harold & Grace Baker Centre Long Term Care Home including more frequent cleaning of high touch surfaces like doors and handrails. Resident rooms, common areas and staff rooms are being disinfected using a Clorox 360 Disinfectant Cleaner system.

To promote physical distancing, residents are being served their meals in their rooms. Group recreation programming has been replaced by one-on-one activities with residents for social engagement.

We have informed residents, their families and the staff on the status of the outbreak. We will continue to reach out to all families of residents as often as possible to provide updates on their loved ones during this time of physical isolation.

Revera continues to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
