

Media Statement – Outbreak over at Holyrood Manor Long Term Care Home – Maple Ridge - Dr. Rhonda Collins, Chief Medical Officer, Revera

January 4, 2021

We received notice yesterday from Fraser Health Authority that the COVID-19 outbreak at Holyrood Manor Long Term Care Home in Maple Ridge is over. The outbreak was declared on November 9 after one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. During this outbreak, two residents and four staff members tested positive for COVID-19. All cases have resolved.

We appreciate the support of Fraser Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
