



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Maplecrest Retirement Residence – Grimsby

We received notice on January 4, from Niagara Region Public Health, that the COVID-19 outbreak at Maplecrest Retirement Residence in Grimsby is now over. The outbreak was declared on December 27 due to possible exposure. There were no cases of COVID-19 among residents or staff.

We appreciate the support of Niagara Region Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents or staff were affected.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
