



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Reachview Village Long Term Care Home – Uxbridge

We received notice today from Durham Region Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Reachview Village Long Term Care Home in Uxbridge is over. The outbreak was declared on January 1 after three staff members tested positive for COVID-19. The staff members have since recovered.

We appreciate the support of Durham Region Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

All Reachview Village residents who have consented and are able to be vaccinated have now received their first dose. Vaccinations for staff are on-going.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
