



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Ridgeview Long Term Care Home – Stoney Creek

We received notice today from Hamilton Public Health Services that the COVID-19 outbreak at Ridgeview Long Term Care Home in Stoney Creek is over. The outbreak was declared on January 20, after one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. That case has now resolved.

We appreciate the support of Hamilton Public Health Services, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

All Ridgeview residents who consented to and were able to be vaccinated have now received their first dose. Vaccinations for staff are also underway.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
