



Media Statement – Outbreak over at Hollyburn House Retirement Residence – West Vancouver

We received notice today from Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH) that the COVID-19 outbreak in the Care Centre area of Hollyburn House Retirement Residence in West Vancouver is over. The outbreak was declared on June 21 after one resident and one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. Both cases have since resolved. Note: this outbreak was limited to the licensed care centre area of the residence and does not involve the independent living or assisted living areas.

We appreciate the support of VCH, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the residence.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our retirement residences and long term care homes.
