



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Carlingview Manor Long Term Care Home – Ottawa

Today, Ottawa Public Health declared the COVID-19 outbreak at Carlingview Manor Long Term Care Home in Ottawa which was announced on July 17 to be over.

The resident whose positive test resulted in the outbreak declaration was retested and found to be negative. Precautionary testing was done for 11 residents and 25 staff and all have now been returned negative, so OPH has declared the outbreak to be over.

The team at Carlingview Manor want to thank Public Health its support and also to thank our residents and their families for their patience and understanding.

We are not letting our guard down now that this potential outbreak is over. We will remain vigilant and continue to monitor residents and screen staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear appropriate PPE at all times.

We will continue to follow all Ministry of Long Term Care directives and Ottawa Public Health protocols and proceed with an abundance of caution.

We are in the process of calling and emailing family contacts to advise them of the end of this potential outbreak and the process for arranging visits.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
