



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Riverside Place Long Term Care Home – Windsor

On July 17, Windsor-Essex County Health Unit declared the COVID-19 outbreak at Riverside Place Long Term Care Home in Windsor to be over. The outbreak involved a positive test received on July 4 for one staff member, a student placement, at the home. The student remains asymptomatic and was tested as part of the regular surveillance testing being done at the home by Public Health.

We appreciate the ongoing support of the Windsor-Essex County Health Unit, our families and the local community as we worked to contain the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear surgical masks at all times.

Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in immediate isolation and tested for COVID-19.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
