



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Carlingview Manor Long Term Care Home – Ottawa

On June 20, Ottawa Public Health declared the COVID-19 outbreak at Carlingview Manor Long Term Care Home in Ottawa to be over. The team at Carlingview Manor and the entire Revera family offer our most sincere condolences to the families and friends of the people we lost to this unprecedented pandemic.

We want to express our gratitude and appreciation for the support we have received from the families of our residents, the wider Ottawa community, Ottawa Public Health, Queensway-Carleton Hospital and the Champlain Health Region during the outbreak.

We also want to thank the staff at Carlingview Manor for your compassion and courage during what has been a very difficult time for you and your families.

We want to assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear surgical masks at all times.

Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in immediate isolation and tested for COVID-19.

We will continue to follow all Ministry of Long Term Care directives and Ottawa Public Health protocols and proceed with an abundance of caution. We will share details of our visitor plan with our family contacts in the coming days.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
