



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at McKenzie Towne Long Term Care Home – Calgary

We received notification today from Alberta Health Services that the COVID-19 outbreak at McKenzie Towne Long Term Care Home in Calgary has been declared over. We truly appreciate the support of AHS Public Health officials, our families and the local community as we worked to contain the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear surgical masks at all times. Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in immediate isolation and tested for COVID-19.

McKenzie Towne will be starting outdoor visits with residents, which have to be booked in advance and following approved AHS guidelines, on June 11.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care and retirement residences homes.
