



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Riverbend Place Retirement Residence – Cambridge

Region of Waterloo Public Health declared the COVID-19 outbreak at Riverbend Place Retirement Residence to be over as of June 7. We appreciate the support of Public Health, our families and the local community as we worked to contain the spread of COVID-19 in the residence.

This outbreak involved one resident in retirement living, who we are happy to say has recovered. None of the residents of Riverbend Place Long Term Care Home or staff were affected.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear surgical masks at all times.

Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in immediate isolation and tested for COVID-19.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our retirement residences and long term care homes.
