



**Media Statement – Outbreak declared over at Telfer Place Retirement Residence – Paris

On June 29, Brant County Health Unit declared the COVID-19 outbreak at Telfer Place Retirement Residence in Paris to be over. We appreciate the support of Public Health, our families and the local community as we worked to contain the spread of COVID-19 in the residence. This outbreak did not affect Telfer Place Long Term Care Home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear surgical masks at all times.

We will follow protocols to gradually reopen the residence in a safe and structured way, including greater resident movement within the building and the gradual resumption of recreation programs. Families will be notified about the resumption of visits.

Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in immediate isolation and tested for COVID-19.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our retirement residences and long term care homes.
