



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Beacon Hill Lodge Long Term Care Home – Winnipeg

We received notice today from Winnipeg Regional Health Authority (WRHA) that the COVID-19 outbreak at Beacon Hill Lodge Long Term Care Home in Winnipeg is over. The outbreak was declared on May 28. During this outbreak, two residents and one staff member tested positive for COVID-19.

WRHA previously reported that four residents and one staff member had tested positive for COVID-19. After review and retesting of swabs, WRHA has rescinded two of the resident cases, reclassifying the original tests as previously recovered cases

One of the resident cases and the staff member's case have now resolved. We regret to confirm one resident passed away with COVID-19 during the outbreak. The team at Beacon Hill Lodge offers its most sincere condolences to the family and friends of the resident who passed away

We appreciate the support of WRHA, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home. Our hearts go out to all who have been affected by this terrible virus.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
