



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Burloak Long Term Care Home – Burlington

We received notice today from Halton Region Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Burloak Long Term Care Home in Burlington is over. The outbreak was declared on February 20 after one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. This case has since resolved.

We appreciate the support of Halton Region Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent/ the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

All Burloak residents who were eligible and consented to be vaccinated have now received their first and second doses. Vaccinations for staff are underway.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
