



**Media Statement – UK Variant Strain of COVID-19 reported at Heritage Lodge – Winnipeg

Since the outbreak was declared on March 10, one resident and one staff member at Heritage Lodge Long Term Care Home in Winnipeg have tested positive for COVID-19. The resident is in isolation in the home and the staff member is in self-isolation at home.

On March 13 we were notified by Winnipeg Regional Health Authority that one Heritage Lodge staff member tested positive for the UK Variant (B.1.1.7) strain of COVID-19. We are awaiting the results of the resident's test to confirm whether or not it is the same strain.

We are committed to doing everything we can to protect the health and safety of our residents, staff members and their families. We are working very closely with Public Health officials and continue to follow strict pandemic outbreak protocols and infection control practices. All residents are monitored twice daily for symptoms.

All staff are screened at the beginning and end of their shifts. All staff are required to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection in the home. Enhanced cleaning is being done at Heritage Lodge. We frequently disinfect high touch surfaces like handrails and doors, common areas and staff rooms.

All residents on the first floor and second floor are to remain in their rooms at all times. Individual recreation activities will be continued to maintain social engagement during this period of isolation. Meals will be served in rooms with supervision and assistance, as required.

We have informed the residents, their families and the staff of the status of this notification. At the direction of Shared Health, general visits are cancelled temporarily. Visits from designated family caregivers and essential visits for palliative residents will be permitted once contact tracing is complete.

Most residents at Heritage Lodge who consented to and are able to be vaccinated have received both doses of the vaccine. Vaccinations for staff are ongoing.

Revera continues to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
