



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Jasper Place Long Term Care Home – Edmonton

We received notice today from Alberta Health Services (AHS) that the COVID-19 outbreak at Jasper Place Long Term Care Home in Edmonton is over. The outbreak was declared on October 23, 2020. During this outbreak, 32 residents and 37 staff members tested positive for COVID-19.

We regret to confirm that nine residents passed away with COVID-19 during the outbreak. The team at Jasper Place offers its most sincere condolences to the families and friends of the people we have lost to the pandemic.

We appreciate the support of AHS, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home. Our hearts go out to all who have been affected by this terrible virus.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, and continue to screen and monitor, residents, staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

Residents of Jasper Place who consented to be vaccinated have now received their second doses. Vaccinations for staff are ongoing.

All families of residents have been informed that the outbreak has been declared over.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
