



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Mount Royal Long Term Care Home – Calgary

We received notice today from Alberta Health Services that the COVID-19 outbreak at Mount Royal Long Term Care Home in Calgary is over. The outbreak was declared on February 15 after one resident tested positive for COVID-19

We regret to confirm that this resident has since passed away. The team at Mount Royal offers its most sincere condolences to the family and friends of the resident who passed away.

We appreciate the support of Alberta Health Services, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home. Our hearts go out to all who have been affected by this terrible virus.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

Most Mount Royal residents who consented to and are able to be vaccinated have now received their second dose, the remaining residents will receive their second dose in the coming weeks. Vaccinations for staff are also underway

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
