



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Poseidon Care Centre – Winnipeg

We received notice today from Winnipeg Regional Health Authority that the COVID-19 outbreak at Poseidon Care Centre in Winnipeg is over. The outbreak was declared on February 21 after one resident tested positive for COVID-19 following a hospital stay. This case has since resolved.

We appreciate the support of Winnipeg Regional Health Authority, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over.

All Poseidon residents who were able to and consented to be vaccinated have now received their second dose. Vaccinations for staff are also underway.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
