



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Sherwood Court Long Term Care Home – Maple

We received notice today from York Region Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Sherwood Court Long Term Care Home in Maple is over. The outbreak was declared on January 14. During this outbreak, six staff members tested positive for COVID-19. All cases have now resolved.

We appreciate the support of York Region Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

All Sherwood Court residents who consented and are able to be vaccinated have now received their first dose and second dose. Vaccinations for staff are also underway.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
