



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Valleyview Care Centre – Brandon

We received notice today from Prairie Mountain Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Valleyview Care Centre in Brandon is over. The outbreak was declared on February 16 after one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. This case has since resolved.

We appreciate the support of Prairie Mountain Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

All Valleyview residents who consented and were able to be vaccinated have received their second dose. Vaccinations for staff are underway.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
