



Media Statement – Ministry Ends Management Order for Westside Long Term Care Home – Toronto

March 25, 2021

Yesterday, the Ministry of Long-Term Care confirmed that it has ended the mandatory management order that was put in place on December 14 for Westside Long Term Care Home in Toronto. Management of the home, which was assigned for 90 days to UniversalCare Canada Inc., has reverted back to Revera.

At the time that the order was issued, Westside was battling an extremely challenging outbreak of COVID-19. The additional support helped to ensure that residents and staff were kept safe. UniversalCare will continue to support Westside over the next three months through periodic check-ins and site visits.

Revera extends its thanks to the UniversalCare team. We are also grateful for the ongoing support and guidance of Toronto Public Health, Central West LHIN, Public Health Ontario, Humber River Hospital and William Osler Health System.
