



Media Statement – Outbreak over at Garden City Manor Long Term Care Home – St. Catharines

We received notice today from Niagara Region Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Garden City Manor Long Term Care Home in St. Catharines is over. The outbreak was declared on November 22, 2020. During this outbreak, 74 residents and 93 staff members tested positive for COVID-19.

We regret to confirm that 22 residents passed away with COVID-19 during the outbreak. The team at Garden City Manor offers its most sincere condolences to the families and friends of the people we have lost to the pandemic.

We appreciate the support of Niagara Region Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to control the spread of COVID-19 in the home. Our hearts go out to all who have been affected by this terrible virus.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

All Garden City Manor residents who consented to and are able to be vaccinated have now received their second doses. Vaccinations for staff are ongoing.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
