



Media Statement – Update on Hollyburn House - Dr. Rhonda Collins, Chief Medical Officer, Revera

April 11, 2020

The one resident and one staff member who tested positive for COVID-19 at Hollyburn House in West Vancouver, British Columbia have both recovered.

While we currently do not have any active COVID-19 cases at Hollyburn House, we nevertheless remain vigilant. Given the increasing numbers of asymptomatic and presymptomatic spread of COVID-19, Revera has now moved to a universal masking policy for all staff. Going forward, all staff working in all areas of our long term care homes and retirement residences will be required to wear masks at all times.

We continue to do enhanced cleaning at Hollyburn House using extra housekeeping staff to do more frequent cleaning. High touch areas like common areas, staff rooms are being disinfected. Group recreation programming has been replaced by one-on-one activities for with residents for social engagement.

Revera continues to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
