



**Media Statement – Update on Humber Valley Terrace Long Term Care Home, Etobicoke
– Dr. Rhonda Collins, Chief Medical Officer, Revera**

April 11, 2020

We have received confirmation from Toronto Public Health that three residents of Humber Valley Terrace Long Term Care Home in Etobicoke have tested positive for COVID-19 and are in isolation at the home.

We are working closely with public health officials and are following strict infection control practices. All staff providing care for residents in isolation (positive for COVID-19 or with respiratory symptoms) must wear full personal protective equipment (PPE), which includes a mask, face shield, gloves and gown, while providing care. All staff have been directed to wear a surgical mask in all areas of the home at all times.

We continue to do enhanced cleaning at Humber Valley Terrace which involves more frequent cleaning of high touch surfaces like handrails, doorknobs and counters. Resident rooms, common areas and staff rooms are being disinfected using a Clorox 360 Disinfectant Cleaner system.

To promote physical distancing, residents are being served their meals in their rooms and group recreation programming has been replaced by one-on-one activities for with residents for social engagement.

We continue to update residents, their families and the staff on the status of the outbreak. We will continue to reach out to all families of residents as often as possible to provide updates on their loved ones during this time of physical isolation.

Revera continues to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
