Today, York Region Public Health declared the COVID-19 outbreak at Mackenzie Place Long Term Care Home in Newmarket to be over.

Our hearts go out to the families and friends of the people we have lost to this unprecedented pandemic, and to those who suffered from effects of the virus and recovered.

We appreciate the support of York Region Public Health, Southlake Regional Health Centre, our families and the local community as we worked to contain the spread of COVID-19 in the home.
