



Media Statement – Parkview Place Long Term Care Home confirms a staff member tested positive for COVID-19 – Dr. Rhonda Collins, Chief Medical Officer, Revera

April 8, 2020

On April 7, we received confirmation that one staff member at Parkview Place Long Term Care Home in Winnipeg, Manitoba, has tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member last worked on April 2 and is at home in self-isolation.

To ensure the safety of our residents and employees, we have implemented full outbreak protocols. This includes closely monitoring other and staff for symptoms.

Overall, since the pandemic was declared, residents and employees of the home have been practicing pandemic protocols. We have undertaken enhanced cleaning of Parkview Place Long Term Care Home by bringing in extra housekeeping staff to do more frequent cleaning, especially in high touch areas like doorknobs, handrails, common areas, staff rooms and seating areas.

Recreation programming has been cancelled to promote physical distancing. Recreation staff will now do one-on-one activities with residents to keep them socially engaged.

We have informed the residents and staff, and are reaching out to all families of residents. We will provide updates to families as often as possible during this outbreak.

Revera continues to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to control and prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
