



Media Statement - Riverside Place Long Term Care Home in Windsor confirms two staff members have tested positive for COVID-19

April 6, 2020

On April 5, we received confirmation that two staff members at Riverside Place Long Term Care Home in Windsor, Ontario, have tested positive for COVID-19. The staff members last worked on March 23 and are at home in self-isolation.

To ensure the safety of our residents and employees, we have implemented full outbreak protocols. We are closely monitoring other residents and staff for symptoms. Any residents who exhibit symptoms will be isolated immediately and tested; any symptomatic staff members will be asked to self-isolate at home.

Overall, since the pandemic was declared, residents and employees of the home have been practicing strict pandemic protocols. We have undertaken enhanced cleaning of all our homes, including Riverside Place Long Term Care Home, including bringing in extra housekeeping staff to do more frequent cleaning of high touch areas like doorknobs, handrails, common areas, staff rooms and seating areas.

Recreation programming has been cancelled to promote physical distancing. Recreation staff will now do one-on-one activities with residents to keep them socially engaged.

We have informed the residents, families of residents and staff. We will provide updates to families as often as possible during this outbreak.

Revera continues to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to control and prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
