



**Media Statement – COVID-19 outbreak declared over at The Claremont Retirement Residence

On May 7, Toronto Public Health declared the COVID-19 outbreak at The Claremont Retirement Residence in Toronto to be over. We appreciate the support of Toronto Public Health, our families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the residence.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, keeping outbreak protocols in place, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms at the start and end of their shifts. All staff will continue to wear surgical masks at all times.

Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in immediate isolation and tested for COVID-19.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our retirement residences and long term care homes.
