



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Carlingview Long Term Care Home – Ottawa

We received notice today from Ottawa Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Carlingview Manor Long Term Care Home in Ottawa has been declared to be over. The outbreak started on November 14 after one asymptomatic staff member tested positive for COVID-19 during surveillance testing. That case has since resolved with no spread to residents or other employees.

We appreciate the support of Ottawa Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
