



**Media Statement – COVID-19 Outbreak over at Miller Crossing Long Term Care Home –
Edmonton - Dr. Rhonda Collins, Chief Medical Officer, Revera**

November 28, 2020

Alberta Health Services declared the COVID-19 outbreak at Miller Crossing Long Term Care Home in Edmonton to be over today. The outbreak was declared on November 7, 2020 after two staff members tested positive for COVID-19. All cases have been resolved.

We want to express our gratitude for the support we have received from the families of our residents and Alberta Health Services.

We want to assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We are maintaining our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff for symptoms, and ensuring that staff wear surgical masks in the home at all times.

We will continue to follow Alberta Health directives and to follow pandemic infection control practices. Any residents or staff displaying any potential symptoms will be placed in immediate isolation and tested for COVID-19.

We are in the process of reaching out to families of residents regarding the resumption of visits.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences
