



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Ridgeview Long Term Care Home – Stoney Creek

On November 18, we received notice from Hamilton Public Health that the COVID-19 outbreak at Ridgeview Long Term Care Home in Stoney Creek was over. The outbreak was declared on November 9 after one staff member tested positive for COVID-19. That case has since resolved.

We appreciate the support of Hamilton Public Health, our residents and families and the local community as we worked to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the home.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring residents and screening staff and visitors for symptoms. Staff will continue to wear an appropriate mask and eye protection at all times.

We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over and that no residents were affected.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
