



**Media Statement – Outbreak over at Marian Chateau Retirement Residence – Regina

We received notice yesterday from the Saskatchewan Public Health Authority that the COVID-19 Outbreak status at Marian Chateau in Regina is closed. The outbreak was declared on October 4. During this outbreak, nine residents tested positive for COVID-19. We regret to report that two residents passed away with COVID-19. The team at Marian Chateau offers its most sincere condolences to the family and friends of the residents who passed away.

We have appreciated the support of Public Health, our residents and families and the local community control the spread of COVID-19 in the home in recent weeks.

We can assure you that we are not letting our guard down now that this outbreak is over. We will maintain our vigilance, monitoring of residents and screening of staff and visitors for symptoms.

All staff are required to wear appropriate personal protective equipment in the home. We are in the process of reaching out to the families of residents to inform them that the outbreak has been declared over. Any residents or staff displaying any future potential symptoms will be placed in isolation and tested for COVID-19.

Revera will continue to do everything we can to keep our residents and employees safe as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at our long term care homes and retirement residences.
